CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Last week I included an extensive review of the number of projects that have been accomplished because of the generous financial support of the parishioners and because of the freely given talents of the craftsmen and women of the parish. Because carpenters, cabinetmakers, electricians, bricklayers and others have donated their time and talent we have done most of our projects just on the cost of the building supplies. What has been done could have cost the parish double or triple. Presently we have received \$85,285 and the projects thus far have required \$71,880.91.

FUTURE WORK

I mentioned at Mass last week that we are having difficulty with our elevator. We have had different companies reviewing the problems, but have yet to find any solutions. Recently we have contracted Otis Elevator Company to fix the elevator. This company charges \$250 an hour with a minimum two hour charge plus travel time. They have been here a number of times and have not been able to find a problem. One thing that is consistent from all the companies called to look at the elevator is that it was installed in 1985 and it is beyond the typical life expectancy. Sooner or later we will have to face the fact that we need a new elevator. The "ballpark" estimates for a new or refurbished elevator are between \$30,000 to \$50,000. Please pray that God will send someone to us who can fix our elevator.

Did you know?**The Prevalence of Abuse in Society**

In surveys of adults, one out of five women and one out of ten men reported that they were sexually molested before they were 18 years old. This means that an estimated 40 million adult survivors of child sexual abuse are living in the United States today. An estimated 9.6% of all school children will be molested by an educator or an employee of a school between kindergarten and 12th grade. Between 13 and 34% of all females will be victims of sexual assault before the age of 18 and 7 to 16% of all males will also be victimized before they are 18.

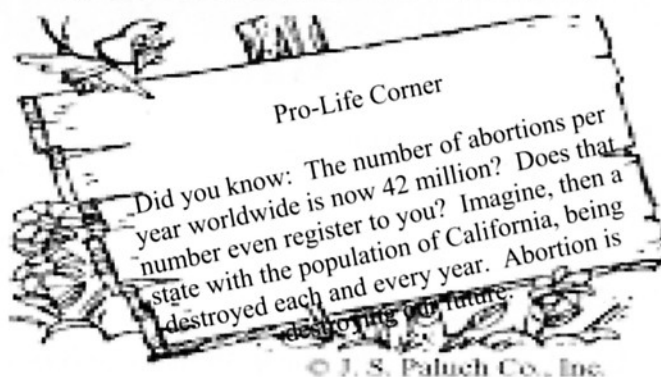
DAILY MASS SCHEDULE

The daily Mass schedules for Word of God and Madonna del Castello are both being reviewed. We are currently surveying all the daily communicants in order to discern what times will serve the parishioners of both parishes the best. A couple things to remember as we enter into this process. First, please feel free to communicate. I welcome all communication and I hope that if the survey sheet is not sufficient to express your concerns adequately then you will seek to address those concerns with Fr Joe or myself. Secondly, in addition to considering the needs of the parishioners we must consider what is possible for the priests. Two priests assigned to the parishes means that each priest gets one day off a week so on that day one priest must fulfill the Mass schedule. Following from that logic--each priest has 52 days off a year which equals 104 days; each priest is permitted 30 days of vacation (though few take that many days off) which equals 60; each priest is permitted one week of retreat and one week of continuing education which equals 28. When one priest is off the other must fulfill the schedule and please include the fact that there will be an estimated 120 or so funerals in the upcoming year.
