DAILY MASS TIME CHANGES

After surveying the daily Mass goers and consulting with both Pastoral Councils, we have decided that the new daily Mass schedule will begin Tuesday, July 5th. The new schedule will be a 7:30 am Mass at Madonna on Monday through Saturday. There will be a 9:30 am Mass at St. Anselm Church on Monday through Friday. WOG funerals will be scheduled at 9:30 am. As a result, some Mass intentions may need to be transferred to another date/time. The School Mass will also be at 9:30 am. There is a weekday noon Mass at St. James Parish, 718 Franklin Ave., Wilkinsburg. This change is necessary for two reasons: 1) our student priests will be transferred to other parishes because the WOG rectory will be closing this summer; 2) the need to develop a schedule that one priest could fulfill. Change is always difficult and sacrifices will have to be made for the common good. The training details five steps to prevent child sexual abuse: Know the warning signs of an inappropriate relationship with a child.

- 1) Know the warning signs!
- Control access to children by carefully selecting the adults who work with children & youth.
 - 3) Monitor all programs for the safety of children & youth.
- Be aware of and sensitive to what is going on in the lives of children.
 - 5) Communicate concerns to the appropriate person in authority.


