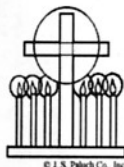

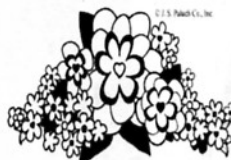

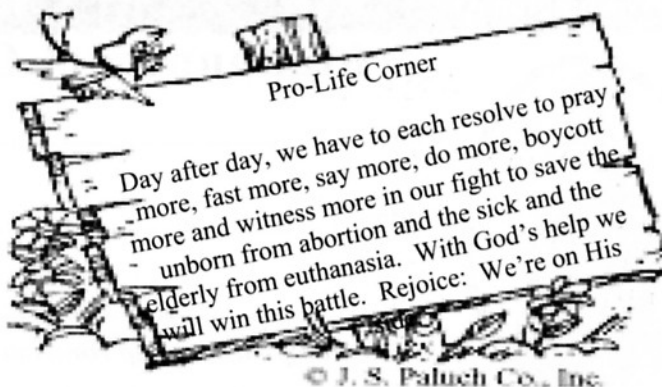
CATHOLIC WOMEN'S CONFERENCE
