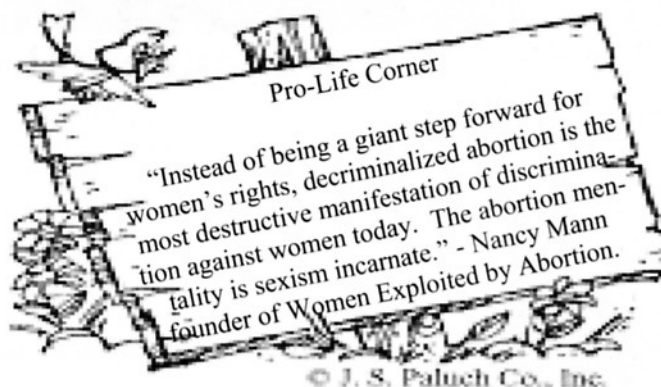
### OUTDOOR MEN'S RETREAT
